## Purpose of Form

A person who is required to file an information return with the IRS must obtain your A person who is required to the an intermation return with the IHS must optain your correct taxpayor identification number (TIN) to report, for example, income paid to you, payments made to you in sattlement of payment card and third party network transactions, real estate transactions, mortgage interest you paid, acquisition or abandonment of socured property, cancellation of debt, or contributions you made

Use Form W-9 only if you are a U.S. person (including a resident alien), to provide your correct TIN to the person requesting if (the requester) and, when applicable, to:

- 1. Certify that the TIN you are giving is correct (or you are waiting for a number to be issued).

- \* An individual who is a U.S. citizen or U.S. resident ation.
- A partnership, corporation, company, or association created or organized in the United States or under the laws of the United States,
- An estate (other than a foreign estate), or
- A domestic trust (as defined in Regulations section 301,7701-7).

Special rules for partnerships, Partnerships that conduct a trade or business in the United States are generally required to pay a withholding tax under section 1446 on any foreign partners' share of effectively connected taxable income from such business. Furtner, in cortain cases where a Form W-9 has not been received, such business. Further, in contain cases where a ream who has not boun received, the nides under section 1446 require a partnership to presume that a partner a foreign person, and pay the section 1448 withholding law. Therefore, if you are a U.S. person that is a partner in a partnership conducting a trade or business in the United States, provide Farm W-9 to the partnership to establish your U.S. status and avoid section 1446 withholding on your share of partnership income
